## Car Detailing Workshop with Darryl Nichols

Odds and Ends Detailing hosted a detailing tutorial on April 9<sup>th</sup> to teach MBCA members how to prepare their vehicles for the Deutsch Marque in May.

Darryl Nichols, Odds and Ends' owner, generously hosted and provided breakfast treats for all that attended, along with professional advice on cosmetic car care.



Darryl showed how to properly wash a vehicle (wheels first!), clay a vehicle to remove surface contaminants, showed methods for sealing/waxing, cleaning engine bay, and clear coat correction. These were just a few of the topics that he discussed and demonstrated during the event.

Darryl takes pride in his work and he does all of the detailing himself. Therefore, his services are by appointment only and, before giving an estimate, he must see your car in person.
